Recap - 72 Hour Fright Fest Challenge - 2014

The first-ever A3F Horror challenge kicked-off October 10-13, 2014 with 39 teams participating from around Arizona. Rookie filmmakers and seasoned veterans took on the task of making a 1-5 minute film in just 3 days or 72 hours.

"We have wanted to host a horror challenge for some time." said Jae Staats, A3F Director and Founder, "It's such a popular genre in today's filmmaking culture. And I am glad we did as it was just a fantastic festival."

This year's guidelines asked the filmmakers to use the Theme, Wrong Turn, a Line of Dialogue, "What was that?" and a Phone as the Prop where one or more characters had to use a phone in some creative way. The results were wildly imaginative and scary-good.

On October 23, 220 people filled up Theatre #4 at AMC Arizona Center 24 Theatres in downtown Phoenix for the premier of the Top 20 films. As the evening quickly unfolded, it became apparent that this would be a very special night of independent films as the enthusiastic and supportive crowd brought a ton of energy to the screening!

"What an amazing atmosphere," remarked Jason, "people didn't want to leave when it was over, they wanted the night to keep going!" An after party at 1130 The Restaurant closed out the festival and another successful A3F event came to an end.
